Delaware Board of Chiropractic Approved Continuing Education Courses July 2022 – June 2024 Renewal Period

The Delaware Board of Chiropractic automatically approves any continuing education (CE) course related to the practice of chiropractic, other than courses on practice management or state laws other than Delaware law, when the course is sponsored or presented by a chiropractic college accredited by the Council on Chiropractic Education (CCE) or by any other national or state chiropractic organization. If the course is sponsored or presented by a CCE-accredited college or another national or state chiropractic organization, it is not necessary to request the Board's pre-approval of the course.

The Board must pre-approve all other CE courses.

Note that **no credit** is given for a course, or part of a course, that deals with practice management or state laws other than Delaware law, regardless of what organization sponsors or presents it.

This following CE courses that the Board has pre-approved are listed alphabetically by the name of the CE provider. These courses may be offered at any time during the two-year approval period. **Contact the providers for detailed information such as dates offered and prices.**

Either a licensee or the provider may submit a course for pre-approval.

To submit a request for a CE course approval, you must use the <u>DELPROS</u> online portal for Service Requests. Go to the <u>Service</u> <u>Request webpage</u> and follow the instructions on how to submit the Service Request.

• It is important to have all your course documentation available as you must upload the information in the Service Request application.

The amount of CE credit that you are required to complete to renew your Delaware Chiropractic license, if any, depends on how long you have held your license. For full details on continuing education requirements, see Section 2.0 of the <u>Board's Rules and Regulations</u>.

Courses are approved for two years. You can offer the course anytime during the two-year approval period. You DO NOT have to request approval when offering the course any additional dates or locations. After a course has been approved, you have to submit a new <u>Service</u> <u>Request</u> and supporting documents only when you:

- change the course content, title, or the amount of hours offered
- wish to continue offering the course after the two-year approval period
